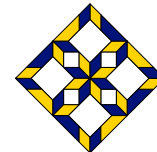

Class Description

CLASS: Ohio Rose taught by Anita Shackelford:

Thursday, June 20, 2013 9 am – noon and 2:00 – 5:00 pm
\$65 (\$55 WV Quilters, Inc. members)
Learn strip ruching and ruching to create surface texture
Plus fine bias stems while making this variation of an Ohio Rose Block.

CLASS: French Braid Quilt taught by Nancy Swisher:

The quilt we will be working on is on page 28 of French Braid Quilts by Jane Hardy Miller. We will start with one braid and you will be able to use as a table runner or the beginning of the quilt.

CLASS: Trapunto with Domestic Machine taught by Anita Shackelford:

Discover how cording, padding and stuffed trapunto can add surface texture to your quilted designs. Create a 12" block design using all three of these raised work techniques and your home sewing machine. Half day. All levels.

CLASS: NOTAN Exploding the Square taught by Cathy Miller:

(Using Mock Mola™ Appliqué)

NOTAN is a Japanese term meaning "light/dark". Artists have been playing with this concept to design exciting positive/negative pieces for years, and now it has been discovered by quilters. The concept is easy: whatever is removed from the centre square gets flipped to the outside of the square. But the possibilities are endless. The class will play with the NOTAN design technique to create a piece which they will then turn into a small (fat quarter sized) quilt, using Cathy's **Mock Mola™** technique. Machine appliqué. Some free motion experience required.

CLASS: Teacher's Medley:

Saturday, June 22, 2013 9:30 am – 11:30 am \$15 per person

Seven of the region's finest teachers will be giving demonstrations on a variety of techniques. You'll have the opportunity to attend a presentation for 15 minutes and then move on to the next teacher until you've been to all seven. 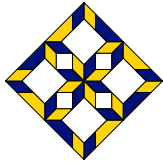

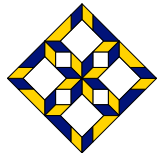
