Patterns are \$10 - payable to me at class.

Several have asked: My fabrics started with a Fat Quarter packet that was "Wild Rose from Marti Michel for Maywood Studios." A previous class found these fabrics on-line.

Precutting instructions. These are **OPTIONAL**. If you want to wait until class to receive my instructions or help on cutting, just wait. If you want to cut before you come to class, here is part of what you need:

IF YOU BOUGHT LAYER CAKES:

Pick 72: 10" squares that will be the background blocks.

On 24 of these squares, draw one line diagonally from one corner to its opposite corner with pencil or chalk. These will be the centers of the blocks.

Pick another 24 of these and cut into 4: 5" squares. You should have 96 colored 5" squares. These will be the corners of the background blocks.

You will have 24 squares that you have not used yet.

Cut 96: 5" squares out of your white or blossom fabrics. These will make your flowers.

Cut 96: 5" squares of fusible web (ie. Wonder Under, Heat n Bond LITE)

IF YOU DID NOT BUY LAYER CAKES:

Cut 48: 10" squares that will be the background blocks.

On 24 of these squares, draw one line diagonally from one corner to its opposite corner with pencil or chalk. These will be the centers of the blocks. You will have 24 squares that you have not used yet.

Cut 96 colored 5" squares. These will be the corners of the background blocks.

Cut 96: 5" squares out of your white or blossom fabrics. These will make your flowers.

Cut 96: 5" squares of fusible web (ie. Wonder Under, Heat n Bond LITE)

NOTE!!!! You may also want to bring 5 ½ yds. of stabilizer (think Sulky Tear-Easy Stabilizer). I did not need to use stabilizer when sewing my blanket stitch, but every machine is different.
