Category Descriptions:

Choose one category for each entry. There is a limit of one entry per category.

- Individual categories are quilts made and quilted entirely by one person.
- Group categories are quilts made by more than one person. Examples include tops pieced by the entrant and quilted by someone else or blocks pieced by someone else and then assembled and quilted by the entrant.
- Bed - any quilt that is intended to be used on a bed, from crib to king.
- Large Wall (any technique) - Perimeter (total of all sides) is 144" or greater.
- Small Wall (any technique) - Perimeter is greater than 96" but less than 144".
- Very Small Wall (any technique) - Perimeter is 96" or less.
- Youth - the maker must be 16 or under. Quilt will not be judged; participatory ribbon will be awarded. Maker must be sponsored (entry fee paid) by a member of the West Virginia Quilters, Inc.

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Quilt Festival Entry Instructions

All entries will be evaluated by a National Quilting Association Certified judge, and written evaluations will be returned to the entrants. Ribbons and awards will be given at the discretion of the judge. The judge and show committee reserve the right to divide or combine categories, to move an entry to a more appropriate category, and not to award all ribbons.

- All entries must be clean, constructed of fabric, and quilted; Yo-Yos, Cathedral Windows and Crazy quilts will be accepted in the "Mixed/Other" category. Preprinted quilt tops or tied comforters will not be accepted.
- Quilts must have been completed after January 1, 2005, and they must not have been displayed in a previous WV Quilters, Inc. show.
- WV Quilters, Inc. will not assume responsibility for fragile embellishments or hanging devices.
- **All quilts must have a 4" hanging sleeve** attached to the back top, and must be labeled on the back with the name of the entrant. For fairness in judging, please cover the name.

Packing/Delivery of the Entries:

Shipped entries:

- Entries must arrive between Monday, June 14, and Friday, June 18, 2010.
- All entries must be shipped in a sturdy box, which will be used for the return shipment.
- Place entry in a plastic bag before placing in the box.
- If you want to be notified of entry's arrival, tape a stamped self-addressed envelope or postcard to the plastic bag.
- Tape an envelope to the plastic bag with the following enclosed:
 - Pre-addressed return label
 - Indication of shipping preference
 - Check or money order for return shipping and insurance (same as your shipping costs).
- Return shipping will be by Thursday, July 1, 2010.

Hand delivered entries:

- Entries must arrive on Tuesday, June 22, 2010 between 10 am and 2 pm.
- When entry is picked up after the Festival **a photocopy of the entry form must be presented.**

Personal pickup will be Saturday, June 26th, between 6:30 and 8 pm.
