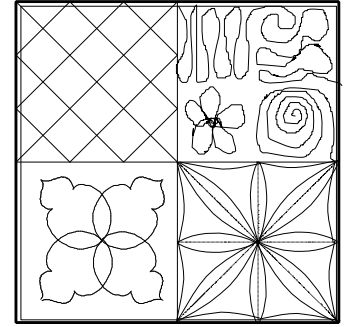


# The Very Basics of Machine Quilting

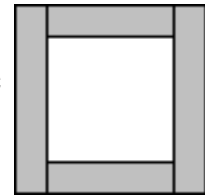
## Description:

Experience the joys of quilting with the “electric needle” - in other words, quilting the three layers of your item using the sewing machine. The session will include lecture/discussion of quilt and machine preparation, thread and batting choices. There will be hands on practice involving machine guided (walking foot) and free motion (darning or free motion foot) techniques. A machine in good working order with a walking foot and a darning or free motion foot is required. Some advanced preparation will be necessary.

## Advance Preparation:

Cut a 12½ " square of plain fabric. Sew 3" borders to all sides. Bring backing (20" square) and thread that matches the plain fabric square.

Bring your machine, machine's manual, a walking foot and a free motion foot. Bring an extension cord.
