Organized by the International Quilt Study Center and Museum in Lincoln, Nebraska, this exhibition features a selection of historical and contemporary quilts chosen for their expressive qualities and sophisticated use of design elements. They include traditional quilts made to be used on beds, many of whose makers are no longer known; quilts from the Amish and from African-American traditions. There are also studio quilts from the beginning of the "art quilt" movement to the present day. There is even a ralli from Pakistan, an example from a rich, non-western quilting tradition.
